

one year's notice. The alternative to a year's delay is assembly-style presentations to the students which stakeholders are willing to embrace.

In the interim, Members agreed to continue its outreach to various stakeholders to introduce the E4J programme. The Secretariat will assist by liaising with stakeholders and arranging the necessary meetings/presentations on behalf of the Commission.

4. Any Other Business

Members noted recent documentation released by media outlets which it will consider when the Commission has quorum. In the interim, Members agreed to continue to monitor all issues/matters that arise concerning conflicts of interest and the integrity of persons in public life.

5. Action Items

The Secretariat was asked to:

- a. Draft correspondence to the Acting Governor to request the appointment of two members to the Commission as detailed above;
- b. Continue to follow-up with educational stakeholders on the E4J programme; and
- c. Liaise with members on their availability for the next meeting upon the appointment of one/more Commission member(s).

The Commission was asked to:

- a. Continue to monitor any issues and matters that arise concerning integrity and conflicts of interest amongst persons in public life; and
- b. Continue to assist in reaching out to stakeholders regarding the E4J programme.

6. Items to be discussed at the next meeting

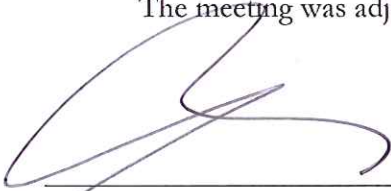
- a. To be determined upon the appointment of one/more Commission member(s).
