Standards in Public Life Law Declaration Documents Available

The Commission for Standards in Public Life has finalised and published the supporting documents related to the filing by Persons in Public Life of declarations (to be entered in the Register of Interests) as mandated by the Cayman Islands Constitution Order, 2009 and the Standards in Public Life Law, 2014 (the “Law”).

Persons in Public Life are encouraged to review and familiarise themselves with these supporting documents which are now available on the Commission’s website. While the Law makes provision for the filing of declarations by persons in public life at different intervals, the cut-off date for the filing of annual declarations, set by section 11(1)(b), is by no later than 30 July in respect of the year ending 30 June of each year. In view of this, persons wishing to file declarations before 30 June 2020 are reminded that they will be responsible for updating their declaration forms within 30 days of any change occurring.

Due to the current shelter-in-place provisions submissions are preferred via email or mail, however, arrangements can be made in advance in order to facilitate visits to the Commissions Secretariat Offices. Declarations must be submitted by the Declarant themselves to ensure there are now issues with lost or late submissions. Should you need to have your declaration witnessed by a member of staff at the Commissions Secretariat, or wish to submit your declaration in-person, please email info@standardsinpubliclifecommission.ky or leave a voicemail on 244-3687.

The Commission is an independent body established under section 117 of the 2009 Constitution to enhance democracy in the Cayman Islands and to ensure that there is sufficient oversight of the public sector.
